#### INTRODUCTION

The Utah Department of Workforce Services compiles quarterly employment and wage data for non-agricultural employers in Utah. Data is maintained at the establishment level (e.g., store, plant, or other type of permanent worksite facility). Since these establishments are assigned an industry and county code, their employment and wage data can be aggregated into common industry and county groupings for analysis purposes.

Employment and wage data for Utah's non-agricultural employers are categorized in this publication by employment size for the month of March in each of the designated years. Grouping data by this criterion provides a useful tool to analyze the characteristics of Utah employers. For example, general trends of the size of Utah employers and employment concentrations by employer size class can be observed. Wage levels for large, medium and small firms can also be evaluated.

In this publication, data is presented for both establishments and firms. The term "establishment" is generally defined as a specific physical worksite for an employer. For most employers, this is the actual street location at which business is conducted. For others, with no permanent worksite (such as salespeople, factory representatives, or distributors) it is the location from which they conduct their business (sometimes even residences).

For construction and some mining firms, it is the Utah headquarters or office location rather than the actual jobsite. Some employers conduct business at multiple establishments or worksites within the state. In this situation, data in the "establishment" tables are presented separately for each establishment or worksite.

In Utah, more than 2,300 firms are multiple worksite employers comprised of more than 21,500 worksite establishments. The term "firm" is used to identify an employer's total statewide operations. In this situation, data for multiple establishment employers are aggregated to a statewide total for assignment to a size category in the firm tables.

#### **SECTION I**

#### UTAH EMPLOYERS, EMPLOYMENT AND WAGES BY SIZE

For the first calendar quarter of each year, establishment employment and wage data are summarized into 10 separate size classes. These 10 classes or categories, which are based on March employment levels, are as follows: 0, 1-4, 5-9, 10-19, 20-49, 50-99, 100-249, 250-499, 500-999, and 1,000 and over.

Since Utah employers are primarily small-sized establishments, the number of establishments in each size category varies inversely with the size class. In fact, more than 99 percent of Utah's establishments employ fewer than 250 workers; and, of these, more than half employ fewer than five workers.

The distribution of employment within these 10 size classes is different from the distribution of the establishments. While more than one-half of the establishments are in the two smallest size classes (employing 0-4 workers) less than 6 percent of non-agricultural employment is there.

The highest non-agricultural employment concentrations are actually found in the middle-size classes with a large concentration also in the largest-size class. The four middle-size classes, employing 10-249 workers, contain more than 57 percent of non-agricultural employment, while less than 25 percent of establishments are represented there.

In general, average monthly wage levels tend to correspond with increases in size class. The first two size classes break this pattern. However, this is primarily due to high concentrations of professional organizations in these small-size classes, which tend to pay higher-thanaverage salaries. These factors raise the average wage level for small firms.



### Percent of Establishments and March Employment First Quarter, 2019







## DEFINITIONS

**NON-AGRICULTURAL EMPLOYMENT:** A three-month average of the number of non-agricultural employees reported to the Utah Department of Workforce Services by employers subject to Utah's unemployment insurance laws, federal agencies in Utah subject to the Unemployment Compensation for Federal Employees (UCFE) program and other Utah nonagricultural employers not subject to unemployment insurance laws.

As a result of multiple job holdings and payroll turnover, some workers are reported by more than one employer. Therefore, the count represents jobs, not persons.

Non-agricultural employment includes most corporation officials, executives, supervisory personnel and clerical workers. It excludes proprietors, self-employed, and unpaid family workers. It also excludes persons who neither worked nor received wages as a result of strikes or work stoppages, temporary layoffs or unpaid sick or vacation leave. **ESTABLISHMENTS:** Any firm, organization or division for which data is separately reported to the Utah Department of Workforce Services (i.e., individual physical facilities, such as stores, plants, offices and other worksites).

**FIRMS:** Data for multiple-establishment employers are aggregated to a statewide total.

**TOTAL WAGES:** All quarterly remuneration paid to nonagricultural workers, including gross wages, commissions, bonuses, cash value of meals, lodging and other gratuities when furnished as payment for the job. Reimbursement for travel or other business expenditures is not included.

**AVERAGE MONTHLY WAGE:** "Total Wages" divided by the number of employees on non-agricultural payrolls.
